




ENVIRONMENTAL CORE SKILLS MODULES

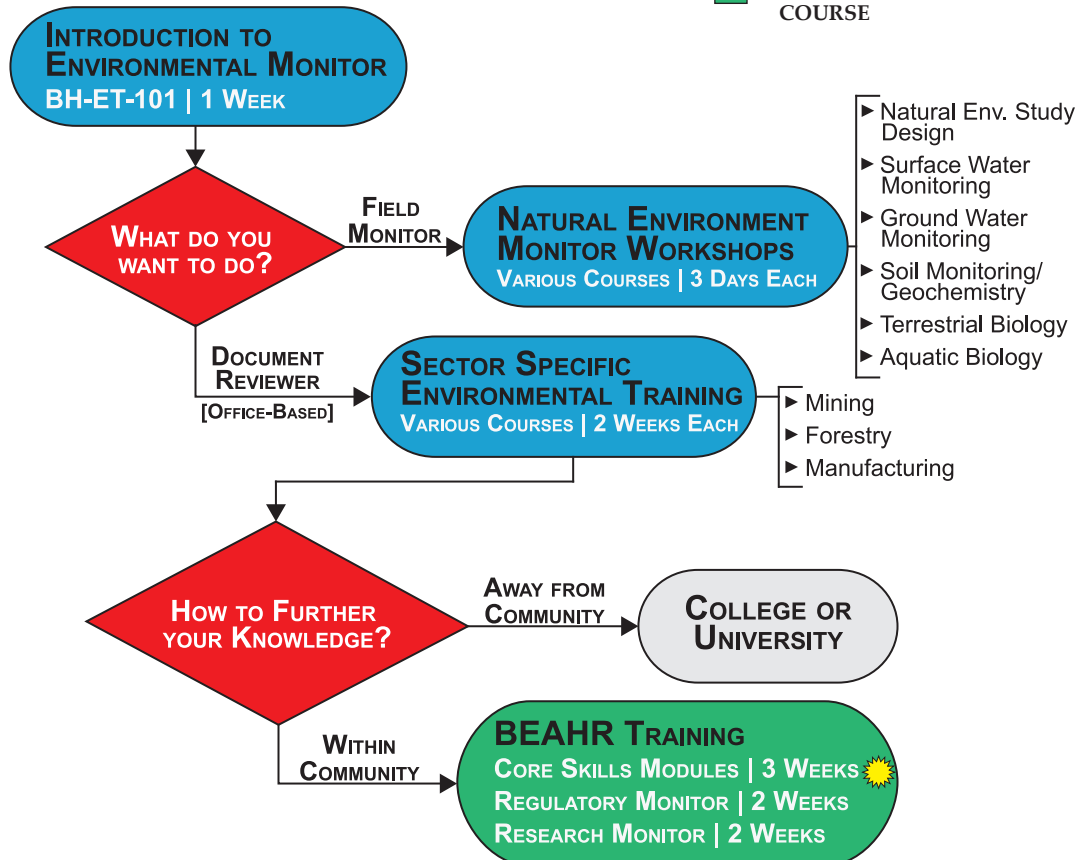
The **Environmental Core Skills Curriculum** is a three week component and should be completed in combination with a minimum of one of the following programs: Environmental Monitoring Coordinator, Environmental Site Assessment Assistant, and/or Contaminated Sites Remediation Coordinator.

The Environmental Core Skills Curriculum consists of five modules, which include:

1. **Foundation Skills**
(such as basic interpersonal and workplace skills)
2. **Introduction to the Environmental Sector**
3. **Technical Skills**
4. **Health & Safety**
5. **Local Knowledge**

FOUNDATION SKILLS

Learn the interpersonal skills and work ethic required to work in the Environmental Sector.

INTRODUCTION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL SECTOR

Participants will receive the basic knowledge of the environmental sector, including common terminology, main activities and tools for environmental planning and monitoring and an overview of the industry and the employment opportunities that it offers.



TECHNICAL SKILLS

Learn the basic skills required to assist in the performance of environmental monitoring work.

Understand the importance of interpreting maps, using communication and recording equipment, and using appropriate measuring systems/instruments.

STRENGTHENING INDIGENOUS COMMUNITIES AND BUSINESSES

HEALTH & SAFETY

Participants will receive the basic knowledge and skills to safely assist in the performance of environmental monitoring work.

This module will teach you the importance of complying with health, safety and environmental requirements; identifying hazardous materials and spills; identifying common causes of hazardous events; and using proper safety equipment.

LOCAL KNOWLEDGE

This module will focus on outlining the importance of integrating local knowledge into environmental monitoring. The main objective of this Module is to provide the participants with basic knowledge and skills to gather and incorporate local knowledge into environmental monitoring work.

Note: Students are required to pass the Environmental Core Skills Modules once, and it does not need to be repeated if the student registers in another program.

Students must meet 80% of the learning outcomes of each module in order to receive a Certificate of Successful Completion, and attend at least 90% of classroom instructional time.
