Research monitors will learn how to assist researchers in monitoring various factors of the environment, such as wildlife counts, surveys and sampling.

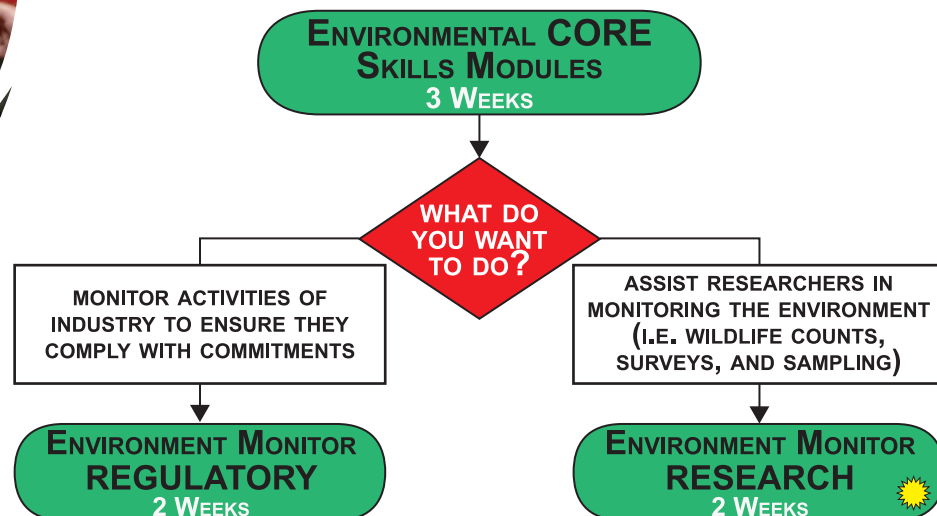
RESEARCH SPECIALIZATION - RESEARCH SKILLS
